Intern Role

To support the Performance Analysis programme of the Welsh Football Trust in the 4 main areas of work; player development, coach education, resource production and national squad support. Working under the supervision of the Performance Analysis Officer, the intern will receive training and development in the latest performance analysis techniques and will have the opportunity to work directly with coaches and players. This is a wideranging role which will provide the successful applicant with the opportunity to develop filming, editing, analysis and interpersonal skills and the chance to work at the elite level of football in Wales.

Essential Requirements

- Undergraduate degree in Sports Science or related subject
- Understanding of football
- Use of own vehicle

Desirable Requirements

- Experience of using Sportscode or related analysis software
- Analysis experience in football

Hours of Work

Average of 25 hours per week (on top of MSc study time), including weekend work and unsociable hours, but not in conflict with course contact time. Internship will continue throughout the year including during university semester breaks.

Duration of Internship

The Internship will run from September 2011 to August 2012.

Place of Work

The Internship will be based at the Welsh Football Trust offices in Nantgarw, Rhondda Cynon Taff, but work will also be undertaken away from the offices. *International travel will* be required.
